

Tools for the Jobsite

- 1 cordless circular saw for ripping poly panels
- 1 table saw for ripping poly sheets
- 4' levels
- Rebar cutter or 4" grinder
- Scaffolding
 - Although not necessary, ICF scaffolding greatly facilitates construction by replacing kicker bracing and increasing jobsite safety
- Power fastener (for attaching C-channels to footing)
- Square
- Chalk line
- String line (for straightening walls)
- Hand saw
- 6' or 8' ladders

Tools Each Worker Should Have

- Tool pouch
- Hammer
- Aviator snips (for cutting stud rails and C-channels)
- Cordless screw gun

Fasteners

- 3" coarse thread drywall screws
- 1 ½" coarse thread drywall screws
- ½" steel stud framing screws (darts) or sheet metal studs
- 1 ¼" round masonry screws

Bracing Materials

- 2x6's for corner bracing
- 2x4's for corner bracing and kickers
- Stakes or pins for anchoring kickers
